

Established evidence reveals that when at least 25 percent of members of parliament are women, laws that discriminate against women are more likely to be repealed (Hallward-Driemeier, Hasan and Rusu, 2013).



# PCBN Early Marriage in Palestine Number of Live Births for the women in the age 20-24 who were married before age 18: According to the population housing and establishments census 2017, the result showed 54,130 births in Palestine (42.8% of them in the West Bank and 57.2% in Gaza strip) were born to those women, in average 2.3 per women, which is high for this age group.
